Procedure: Light power washing to remove surface dirt and contamination.
Tape, mask and cover areas as needed.
Apply (1) full primer bonding coat and (2) finish coats.
Color and sheen factor to be determined.

Objective: To present a lighter finish color for a more acceptable look while also allowing the building to reflect light and the sun's heat. A lighter color will help keep the interior of the building cooler while lowering energy costs.

Scaffold will be required.

Total Labor, scaffolding and materials: \$16,440.00.
Foreman on site at all times.
Premium products from Benjamin Moore Paints.
Keep site clean and orderly during and at the end of each day.
