CONSENT CALENDAR

**MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY 8, 2012 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE KENSINGTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

PRESENT: Directors: Helmut Blaschczyk, Joe de Ville, Nina Harmon, Janice Kosel, Leslie Michael
Staff: Chief Lance Maples, Manager Brenda Navellier

CALL TO ORDER:

President Kosel called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and noted that all Directors were in attendance.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT ITEMS:

President Kosel called for approval of the consent calendar (items 3, 4 & 5) consisting of approval of the minutes of the January 11, 2012 meeting, approval of the monthly transmittal #8, and approval of the December/January 2012 monthly financial report. Director Michael made a motion to accept the consent calendar items as presented. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS:

Resident Joan Gallegos commented on yesterday's Board of Supervisor hearing for the Clean Water Initiative. Funds from unincorporated areas will go the County, not the community. This county-wide fee will now be going to a mail ballot. Gallegos will share the brochure she received in the mail with the Board.

Resident Anthony Knight asked about the dangers of PG&E residential feeder lines. Chief Maples explained PG&E's communications and attempt at transparency since the San Bruno event. They have created a public agency portal and they are currently working on a public portal.

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Maples reported that February is American Heart month and he stressed the importance of taking a CPR class every few years. The Fire Department averages 10 to 15 participants per month in its classes. Arlington Community Church and the Kensington library both have AEDs. The Board discussed placement of additional AEDs in Kensington and the varied symptoms of heart attacks.

Maples added that Rodeo-Hercules had voted to postpone the closure of a station at their last meeting that he attended.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Kosel reported that LAFCO has a vacancy and will hold an election in April at the CSDA chapter meeting. Director Harmon will attend the meeting on KFPD's behalf and cast the District's ballot. The filing date for candidates has not yet passed.

Director Kosel displayed the District of Distinction plaque that de Ville and Harmon received at the January CSDA chapter meeting. Kosel thanked the Board members and noted that it is through their efforts that the District is able to qualify for this distinction.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mid-Year Budget Review: President Kosel reported that the Finance Committee had met late in January to review the budget to date. No changes are recommended at this time. Kosel reviewed the budget to date and noted some of the highlights. The District is currently \$100,000 under budget on expenses. \$60,000 of that is budgeted for water systems that will be spent but is behind schedule. Due to the capital outlay and water systems, the overall projected expenses are nearly \$700,000 more than revenue for this fiscal year only. The building renovation is budgeted at \$575,000 but is \$30,000-40,000 under budget plus the District received \$176,000 from the surety bond

company. The net result is that the District's cash position falls from \$5 million to \$4.3 million in FY11-12 which is allocated to capital replacement funds, the CalPers retiree trust and the contract set-aside. FY12-13 planning budget comes within \$50,000 of balancing even with the water system improvement projects that will carry over into that year. With the capital budget, total expenses will be \$60,000 over revenue. Long-term projections consider minor raises to the employee group in the coming years due to the economy. No action is proposed at this time.

Resolution 12-02 Recognizing February as Heart Safe Month: KFPD is recognizing February as American Heart Month, the importance of CPR training and the placement of AED's in public places. Director Blaschczyk made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-02. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

BOARD REPORTS:

Finance Committee: Committee minutes of May 24 and July 26, 2011 that were approved at the January 2012 meeting were included in the packet.

Public Safety Building: Board members commented on the how nice the new landscaping looks.

CSDA: Harmon, deVille, Maples and Navellier attended the January 23rd meeting. Lisa Vorderbrueggen of the West County Times was the speaker.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m.


SUBJECT: Incident Activity Reports for the Month of January





Fire Prevention 2011

This year the Kensington Fire Protection District, Fire Prevention Division continued to have an extremely busy and very successful year. The major programs the Fire Prevention Division is involved in include: Mercantile Fire Safety Inspections, New Building Construction which includes plan reviews and field inspections, Public Education and our Weed Abatement Program. These four programs keep the Prevention Division extremely busy throughout the year and provide us with our greatest challenges and rewards.

Mercantile Fire Safety Inspections: Kensington has nearly 100 businesses that are inspected annually by on duty engine companies. There are typically five types of inspections our engine companies conduct. They are; General Fire Safety Inspections, Fire Sprinkler Inspections, Fire Alarm Inspections, Hazardous Occupancy Inspections and Commercial Cooking Fire Suppression (Hood & Duct) Inspections. Many of the businesses that are inspected by engine companies receive multiple inspections concurrently, i.e. Fire Safety and Fire Sprinkler. Some require all five inspection types to be conducted. Of these businesses, we had a 90% completion rate. The businesses that do not comply are forwarded to the Fire Prevention Officer to ensure Fire Code compliance is met. The result of our comprehensive Fire Safety Inspection Program makes us one of the lowest fire losses in commercial occupancies in the state.

New Building Construction: New building construction includes plan review, on site inspections and final inspections. In 2011, we completed eight plan reviews and 21 construction site inspections. Construction site inspections conducted by the Prevention Division mainly focus on Life Safety Systems. The majority of these site inspections include fire sprinkler, fire alarm system installation and acceptance, water supply and hydrant spacing, commercial cooking facility fire suppression systems, emergency exiting and lighting.

Public Education: Public Education continues to evolve. The infant car seat installation program continues to be a great success, which resulted in the safe installation of 56 individual infant car seats. Our Fire Department car seat installers have also worked with John Muir Hospital hosting a car seat installation workshop and have participated in other car seat installation workshops throughout the region installing car seats with John Muir. In addition to installing the car seats, our fire department installers train new parents how to correctly and safely install or transfer their car seats in their vehicles.

The "Smokey Bear" suit and "Pluggie" the Fire Hydrant continue to be a great success in public education. Again this year we have conducted fire safety education for citizens of all ages using these fire prevention tools to reach the public. We have achieved this by being extremely active in seeking opportunities to educate the public in fire safety. The main avenues we reach the public through are; fire station tours, going to public and private schools and other public events, Tri City Safety Day, Fourth of July and Halloween. The Smokey Bear suit and "Pluggie" the Fire Hydrant have been used at several Kensington sponsored events. In addition, we have conducted CPR/First Aid classes for the public that has drawn 105 students. The citizens of Kensington are excited and eager to seize every opportunity to learn about fire safety.

Weed Abatement: Our Weed Abatement program remains our most challenging and time consuming program. The program consists of inspecting every property within Kensington identifying fire hazards and having those fire hazards removed or brought into acceptable levels. After every property is inspected, a letter on non-compliance is sent to those properties and property owners that do not comply with the Districts "Vegetation Management Standards". This year we sent out more than 56 notices and all of the properties were brought into compliance voluntarily. This was achieved through the hard diligent work of Prevention Department personnel, making hundreds of phone calls and numerous site visits educating property owners of the risk and standards they were to maintain.

Each year, tons of harmful and dangerous pollutants, bacteria and trash are carried through our communities and enter local creeks, reservoirs, lakes, the Delta and Bay. As water drains from streets, parking lots, and lawns, pollutants are picked up and enter the drainage system through thousands of catch basins throughout Contra Costa County. From there, this polluted water flows through a system of pipes, open channels and creeks into the Delta and Bay.


The Contra Costa Clean Water Program is composed of Contra Costa County, all of its nineteen cities and towns, and the Contra Costa County Flood Control & Water Conservation District. These twenty-one agencies are working cooperatively to prevent water pollution, but much more needs to be done to protect and improve local water quality. Also, new and expanded State and Federal clean water mandates require local communities to pay large fines if creeks, reservoirs, lakes, the Delta and Bay are not cleaned up. 





Information About Your Proposed Clean Water Fee

The proposed annual Clean Water fee for your property is printed on the official ballot included with this ballot guide. The total amount that would be raised County-wide by the proposed 2012 Community Clean Water Initiative for fiscal year 2012-13 is approximately \$8+ million. The proposed Clean Water fee is based on the cost of clean water and pollution control services and facilities needed to improve water quality and comply with federal and state mandates. The proposed Clean Water fee is calculated based on the average impervious surface (surfaces not permeable by water, such as driveways, pavement and buildings) for properties of different types and sizes. For example, properties with large impervious areas send more polluted water into the storm drain system than property types without impervious surfaces, such as open space.

The proposed annual Clean Water fee can only be increased by the consumer price index, or two percent, whichever is less. This will help ensure that Clean Water fee revenues keep pace with the cost of operating and maintaining our clean water and water pollution control services and facilities in future years. For more information, contact the Clean Water Program and/or review the Clean Water Fee Report available from the Program. Moreover, if approved, the Clean Water fee will be levied annually for a period not to exceed 10 years.

Balloting Process

If you have questions about the Clean Water fee or the proposed clean water services, lose your official ballot, require a replacement official ballot, need a proportional official ballot so you can vote your share of your property separately from other owners, or want to change your vote, call the Clean Water Program at (925) 313-2360. The Clean Water fee shall not be imposed if, upon the conclusion of the tabulation, official ballots submitted in opposition to the fee exceed the official ballots submitted in favor of the fee. Failure of any person to receive a ballot(s) shall not invalidate the proceedings.




Spring Vegetation Management Inspections

Last October marked the 20-year anniversary of the 1991 Oakland-Berkeley Hills fire. Much of the street layout and topography in Kensington are similar to those in the Oakland-Berkeley hills. Fire District Ordinance and State Law requires all home and property owners, and renters, to remove flammable vegetation around their residences. Protecting your home and the community from the devastating effects of wildfire is the property owner's responsibility.

The community of Kensington is in a "Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone." KFPD is requesting voluntary compliance and citizen involvement in the reduction of fire hazards in our community. Fire department personnel will check for compliance with these standards beginning in May. For the past several years, voluntary compliance by the community has been outstanding and we again look forward to everyone's cooperation this year.

You, as the property owner, are the most important person when it comes to protecting your home from a wildfire. If you need guidance in resolving a fire hazard on your property, please call the Fire Prevention Officer at (510) 215-4457 for assistance. We are happy to help!



Trim all trees at least 10 feet from the ground.

Vegetation management tips:

All lots

- Trim trees up 10 feet from the ground. Remove dead and dying branches, loose and papery bark, and fallen branches.
- Cut trees 10 feet back from chimney openings.
- Install a spark arrestor on all chimneys and stovepipes.
- Keep roof and decks free of leaves, needles, twigs or other dead vegetation.
- Fire resistive plants and shrubs are recommended.
- All abatement must be maintained throughout fire season.

Large lots

- Maintain a 30-foot firebreak from all structures to property lines. Only well-tended, properly irrigated or ornamental vegetation is allowed. Remove all dead, diseased or otherwise flammable material.
- For parcels that extend 30 to 100 feet from the house, reduce the height of flammable vegetation (grass and weeds to 6 inches or less; brush to 18 inches or less).



The Elections and Bylaws Committee is looking for Independent Special District Board Members or their General Managers who are interested in leading the direction of the California Special Districts Association for the 2013 - 2015 term.

The leadership of CSDA is elected from its six geographical regions. Each of the six regions has three seats on the Board with staggered 3-year terms. Candidates must be affiliated with an independent special district that is a CSDA regular member located within the geographic region that they seek to represent. (See attached Region Map)

The CSDA Board of Directors is the governing body responsible for all policy decisions related to CSDA's member services, legislative advocacy, education and resources. The Board of Directors is crucial to the operation of the Association and to the representation of the common interests of all California's special districts before the Legislature and the State Administration.

Commitment: Serving on the Board requires one's interest in the issues confronting special districts statewide. A board member is expected to attend all board meetings held every other month, usually on the second Friday of the month, at CSDA's office in Sacramento. Besides serving on the Board, each Board Member is expected to participate on at least one committee, which usually meets 3-4 times a year in Sacramento. CSDA reimburses directors for their related expenses for Board and Committee meetings as outlined in Board Policy. In addition, all Board Members are expected to attend CSDA's two annual events: Special Districts Legislative Days (held in the spring) and the Annual Conference (held in the fall) as part of their obligation to the CSDA membership; expenses for these two events are not reimbursed by CSDA, even if a board meeting or committee meeting is held in conjunction with the event.

Nomination Procedures: Any regular member Independent Special District is eligible to nominate one person, a board member or managerial employee (as defined by that district's Board of Directors), for election to the CSDA Board of

Directors. A copy of the member district's resolution or minute action must accompany the nomination. The deadline for receiving nominations is May 25, 2012. Nominations and supporting documentation may be mailed or faxed.

Nominees will receive a Candidate's Packet in the mail. The packet will include campaign guidelines.

CSDA will mail ballots on June 8th. The ballots must be received by CSDA no later than 5:00 p.m. August 3, 2012 and must be the original ballot (no faxes or e-mails). The successful candidates will be notified no later than August 7th. All selected Board Members will be introduced at the Annual Conference in San Diego, CA in September.
