#### **READY, SET, GO!**

#### Ready,

1. Register to receive emergency alerts. Visit: www.cwsalerts.com.

- 2. Text your zip code to 888777 from your mobile phone to receive Nixel Text Alerts.
- 3. Visit kensingtonfire.org/drill to read the evacuation drill objectives and plan.

Encourage neighbors to register and particpate.

#### Set,

- 1. Have your Go Bag accessible.
- 2. Learn multiple evacuation route options.

Improve evacuation efficiency by adopting your street's car parking etiquette. Collaborate with your neighbors to establish best practices.


#### **GO!**

- 1. On April 9th at 9:00 am, You will receive a message from CWS. This message will include instructions specific to your street. Visit kensington-fire.org/drill to see what you should expect.
- 2. After the evacuation drill, please complete the online survey provided with the CWS alert. This survey will give first responders valuable information to improve emergency planning.

This drill is voluntary; however, participation is critical to planning for an emergency. We encourage every resident to be aware of the Kensington Evacuation Drill and the intent to increase preparedness and resiliency in the community.

The new sign at the turn down Sunset from the Arlington was blocked by tall hedges.


I received call at 9am, loaded for bags and pets and was at the checkin site by 9:14am.

Drivers paused before taking Wellesley because there is often oncoming traffic.






Please indicate which route you took.




How well prepared are you are for a disaster? (Earthquake, Wildfire) 286 responses




Please indicate which of the following preparedness actions that you have taken. (Please check all that apply)







During an actual evacuation would you be willing/able to check on your neighbors before leaving in your vehicle?







During an actual evacuation do you have any condition or situation which make you likely to NEED ADDITIONAL TIME OR ASSISTANCE before leaving in your vehicle?
