CONSENT CALENDAR

**MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 8, 2012 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE KENSINGTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

CALL TO ORDER:

President Kosel called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and noted the Directors and staff that were in attendance.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT ITEMS:

President Kosel called for approval of the consent calendar (items 3, 4, 5 & 6) consisting of approval of the minutes of the June 13, 2012 meeting, approval of the June incident activity report, approval of the monthly transmittal #2, and approval of the May/June 2012 monthly financial report. Director Blaschczyk made a motion to accept the consent calendar items as presented. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS:

Navellier pointed out a run-on error on item 9 of the agenda that should be struck. All necessary information to conduct item 9 is listed and correct.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

Captain Janes worked three different incidents in Colorado between June 25th and July 12th. B/C Gibson, Captain Grunseth, Captain Hoyer-Nielsen, Engineer Cesmat, and Firefighter Grupalo CFD all reported to the Robbers Fire near Auburn from July 12th through the 17th.

Chevron had an incident of magnitude this past Monday, August 6th. Chief Maples and B/Cs Dougery and Gibson all worked the incident. There were minor injuries to three Chevron employees. The fire went from normal to extreme very rapidly. A Type I engine was destroyed during the fire. El Cerrito-Kensington engines helped cover the calls into Richmond. This was a great example of a successful auto and mutual aid event. All agencies moved up to help as they should have. Maples said he is satisfied that our firefighters have the proper equipment and training to assist at a Chevron fire. Chevron provides training at no cost through Texas A & M. Maples said that communications were also adequate. The community warning system sounded 10 minutes after the fire started. Sirens continued to run every 45 minutes. The news reported the shelter-in-place for Richmond, No. Richmond and San Pablo. There was no shelter-in-place for El Cerrito or Kensington but there was a health advisory. County Health was taking air samples to make these determinations. If you can hear the sirens, shelter-in-place and turn on the radio/TV for information. The next newsletter will report on how to sign-up for reverse 911 on a cell phone. Maples reported that there 3 Chevron engines, 5 Richmond engines, 5 strike teams and 5 petrol mutual-aid engines, totaling 18 engines.

EBMUD started the upgrades on Arlington/Westminster this week. The County has requested traffic flag control which will increase the project cost by an estimated \$20-30,000.

Maples attended today's LAFCO meeting to provide a fire service update for El Cerrito and Kensington. LAFCO seems to have a better understanding of their role, what they can and can't enforce and taking into consideration a community's political will. Maples gave the Board an overview of his LAFCO report. There have been many consolidations during the past 40 years. The Contra Costa County Chief commented during the meeting that there is not necessarily any savings in considering current consolidations. All agencies have already scaled down through JPAs, automatic aid, shared training, etc. LAFCO has been helpful in bringing all fire agencies together to discuss current issues with the press also in attendance. Maples further discussed partnerships and auto/mutual aid and its necessity.

Tri-City Safety Day will take place on Saturday, September 8 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. President Kosel said KFPD is happy to provide lunch for the workers as usual.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

President Kosel reported that KFPD participated in the 4th of July fair in El Cerrito. KFPD's engine will participate in the Solano Stroll on September 9th. Kosel will report on KFPD's current achievements at the annual KIC meeting on September 22nd. There will be agency updates and also election candidates. September's KFPD meeting will focus on the annual budget. Kosel and Blaschczyk will be reviewing the final budget prior to that meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Public Hearing – Resolution 12-08 Declaring Weeds, Rubbish, Litter or other Flammable Material on Designated Private Properties Constitutes a Public Nuisance and Providing for Notice that the Fire Chief or Designee Shall Abate Such Public Nuisance Conditions if not Abated by the Property Owner: President Kosel explained the process of the annual vegetation management program and noted Exhibit A that lists 18 properties that are not in compliance with Kensington's vegetation standards. FPO Ciappara said that 131 Lawson Road has cleared their property and should be removed from the list on Exhibit A. No one was present from any of the other 17 properties to protest their property being listed. President Kosel then opened the public hearing and called for the staff report and recommendation. FPO Ciappara introduced himself to the Board. He reported that 70 initial properties were narrowed down to the current 17. Ciappara reviewed the entire vegetation management process. After the public hearing, a final declaration of public nuisance will be mailed dated 8/9/12. Abatement will take place between 8/15 and 8/29/12. Ciappara answered several questions about the process. President Kosel closed the public hearing.

Director de Ville made a motion to enact Resolution 12-08 as submitted with the deletion of 131 Lawson Road from Exhibit A. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Kosel noted that there is usually tremendous voluntary compliance in the community and Maples said it is not the District's desire to abate property owners. Ciappara explained how he goes parcel-to-parcel and usually speaks to every parcel owner in person.

BOARD REPORTS:

Finance Committee: Will report in September with the final budget.

Diablo Fire Safe Council: There is a new round of cost share neighborhood grants being distributed.

Resident Anthony Knight asked about the two open positions on the Board of Directors and if there were any applicants for the positions. The County will have the current information.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 8:28 p.m.


SUBJECT: Incident Activity Reports for the Month of July



Department Responds to Lake County Fires

On August 13, 2012 at 6:00 am Battalion Chief Michael Pigni was dispatched as a Strike Team Leader trainee to lead resources from Pinole Fire Department, Moraga – Orinda Fire Protection District, San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District, Contra Costa County Fire Protection District as well as El Cerrito-Kensington Fire Department to the Wye Fire in Lake County which had started the evening before around 4:00 pm. Captain Larry Carr, Engineer/Paramedic Traviss Crumpacker, Engineer/Paramedic Peter Benson and Firefighter/Paramedic Damien Carrion staffed Engine 372 on this team. There were actually two fires in this area, the Wye Fire and the Walker Fire that was a couple of miles apart and had grown to over 5,000 acres in less than 12 hours. Both of these fires were grouped together as one incident by Monday morning. The Strike Team arrived at the fire at 10:00 am and was assigned to assisting with suppression and structure protection operations. The crews remained on duty through the night for 24 hours straight until they were released back to camp for rest and rehab. The Strike Team remained assigned to the incident through Friday, August 17, 2012, at which time the fire had increased in size to almost 8,000 acres but was over 50% contained. There were no injuries during this assignment and everyone returned home at approximately 4:00 pm.

Fire Department Staff Assists with Fires in Plumas National Forest

On August 15, 2012 at 8:00 am, Captain/Paramedic Kevin Janes was activated as part of a Federal Incident Management Team to work as a Communication Unit Leader Trainee on the Chips Fire in the Plumas National Forest. Kevin is responsible for the daily communication plan, programming staff radios and works with other communication support personnel to ensure the incident communication needs are met. The fire which started on July 29, 2012 has grown to over 50,000 acres and has spread to the Lassen National Forest is only 37% contained. This fire is located in extremely rugged country and has forced the evacuations of numerous communities off and on depending on its direction of travel. Captain Janes reported yesterday that even their base camp is being threatened by the fire and they are making contingency plans to evacuate camp and keep a limited team to defend the infrastructure. The fire, which has already been burning for over three weeks, is not expected to be contained until the end of this month. Kevin will be deployed on this incident for a maximum of 21 days. He reports that all is well.

Department Responds to the Shasta Area Lighting Fires

Captain Larry Carr, Captain Jose Castrejon, Engineer/Paramedic Chris Renshaw and Firefighter/Paramedic Tom Wade responded Sunday morning at 1:00 am with the OES engine to the Redding area as part of a multi-county strike team of OES engines from the Bay Area. The OES engines which are owned by the State were dispatched to assist with the numerous lightning caused fires in the Shasta area. Our crews arrived in the area by dawn and were assigned to direct suppression activities and structure protection in the community of Shingletown. They worked through the day and night and were finally relieved Tuesday afternoon after being on the line for over 30 hours to return to the base camp to rehab. They are assigned to the Ponderosa Fire which at this point is over 20,000 acres and is approximately 35% contained. There are almost 2,000 personnel on this incident and over 200 fire engines. At last report the fire had calmed down as the weather was cooperating which was assisting in crews getting the upper hand. Local resources will probably be out through the end of the week.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KENSINGTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FINAL COMBINED BUDGET FOR REVENUE, OPERATING EXPENDITURES, AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT EXPENDITURES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Kensington Fire Protection District has developed and adopted by Resolution on June 13, 2012 a preliminary Combined Revenue, Operating Expense and Capital Improvement Budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Kensington Fire Protection District has approved or otherwise established the amount budgeted for the annual fee for services from the City of El Cerrito for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary Combined Revenue, Operating Expense and Capital Improvement Budget adopted by the Board of Directors of the Kensington Fire Protection District under Resolution 12-07 is subject to final adoption by the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with the laws of the State of California, the Kensington Fire Protection District did post a notice of a public meeting on the adoption of the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 at least 14 days prior to September 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of California require the Kensington Fire Protection District to adopt a final budget for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, a copy of which is attached to and made part of this resolution.





You can learn CPR by taking






Reverse 911 Notification System

Water System Fireflow Improvements

During the months of August and September, East Bay Municipal Utility District, on behalf of the Kensington Fire Protection District, will be making improvements to the water main that runs along Arlington Avenue between Sunset Ave. and Westminster Ave. and turns east up Westminster.

District funded improvements to the water main improve the fire hydrant flow in the event of a major conflagration.

This is the sixth phase of improvements in the community in which the District has partnered with EBMUD.

This phase replaces 1,500 feet of 6-inch water main with an 8-inch water main in order to improve the water pressure in the area. Once the improvements are complete, it is anticipated that the changes will bring this area to a point where 1,500 gallons per minute (gpm) can be achieved from

any two hydrants. This gpm goal was determined in KFPD's 1998 Water System Improvements Master Plan.

In addition to the previous five phases of pipe line improvements, 32 hydrants have been added throughout the Kensington community during the past 10 years.

The Arlington/Westminster improvements is a cost-share project between KFPD and EBMUD.

CSDA is conducting a call for nominations for a Region 3, Seat A Director for the remainder of the 2010-2012 term, concluding on December 31, 2012. A vacancy has occurred on the CSDA Board and pursuant to the CSDA Bylaws, Article 3, Section 6C:

In the event of a vacancy occurring “after” the nomination period has closed, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment. Notification of the vacancy and request for nominations shall be sent to all regular members in the region in which the vacancy occurred.

The region’s existing directors sitting on the CSDA Board shall interview all interested candidates of that region and bring a recommendation to the Board of Directors of the CSDA. The Board shall make the appointment to fill the unexpired term of the vacated Board position.

The leadership of CSDA is elected from its six geographical regions. Each of the six regions has three seats on the Board with staggered 3-year terms. Candidates must be affiliated with an independent special district that is a CSDA regular member located within the geographic region that they seek to represent. (See attached Region Map)

The CSDA Board of Directors is the governing body responsible for all policy decisions related to CSDA’s member services, legislative advocacy, education and resources. The Board of Directors is crucial to the operation of the Association and to the representation of the common interests of all California’s special districts before the Legislature and the State Administration.

Commitment: Serving on the Board requires one’s interest in the issues confronting special districts statewide. A board member is expected to attend the remaining two board meetings in 2012 after appointment. Besides serving on the Board, each Board Member is expected to participate on at least one committee, which usually meets 3-4 times a year in Sacramento. CSDA reimburses directors for their related expenses for Board and Committee meetings as outlined in Board Policy. In addition, all Board Members are expected to attend CSDA’s Annual Conference (held in the fall) as part of their obligation to the CSDA membership; expenses for this event are not reimbursed by

CSDA, even if a board meeting or committee meeting is held in conjunction with the event.

Nomination Procedures: Any regular member Independent Special District is eligible to nominate one person, a board member or managerial employee (as defined by that district's Board of Directors), for election to the CSDA Board of Directors. **A copy of the member district's resolution or minute action and a letter of experience or resume from the nominee must accompany the enclosed nomination form. The deadline for receiving nominations is September 14, 2012.** Nominations and supporting documentation may be mailed or faxed.

Nominated candidates will then be interviewed by the Region's existing directors and the successful candidate will be appointed by vote of the CSDA Board.
